

Tea-Cozy Hat

Materials:

100g/125m/137yds Debbie Bliss Maya (100% Wool)

OR 100g/135yds/126m Hand Painted Yarn.com Handspun Bulky (100% Wool)

Set 5mm DPN's or size needed to obtain gauge

Tapestry needle

Stitch markers as necessary

Gauge:

16 sts to 10cm/4" on 5mm needles over St.St

Sizes:

To fit size: 20 (22, 23) inches, 51 (56, 58.5) cm

Finished size: 18 (19.5, 21) inches, 46 (49.5, 53) cm

Abbreviations:

- K – knit
P – purl
M1 – pick up the horizontal loop between next 2 sts, place it onto the left needle then knit into the back of it
K2tog – knit next 2 sts together
yo – yarn over needle

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How to:

Cast on 72 [78, 84] sts
Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.
Place stitch marker to indicate start of rnd.

Brim:

Now work for the brim by knitting 2x2 rib (K2, P2) every rnd for 2 inches/5 cm (or desired length)

Body:

Change to stocking stitch and knit every rnd until work measures 6 [6.5, 7] inches/15 [16.5, 18] cm from cast-on edge.

Crown shaping:

Small size jump to Rnd 3, Medium size jump to Rnd 2, Large size start at Rnd 1.

- Rnd 1: *K12, K2tog; rpt from * to end [78 sts]
Rnd 2: *K11, K2tog; rpt from * to end [72 sts]
Rnd 3: *K10, K2tog; rpt from * to end [66 sts]
Rnd 4: *K9, K2tog; rpt from * to end [60 sts]
Rnd 5: *K8, K2tog; rpt from * to end [54 sts]
Rnd 6: *K7, K2tog; rpt from * to end [48 sts]
Rnd 7: *K6, K2tog; rpt from * to end [42 sts]
Rnd 8: *K5, K2tog; rpt from * to end [36 sts]
Rnd 9: *K4, K2tog; rpt from * to end [30 sts]

Prepare for the drawstring:

- Rnd 10: *K15, M1; rpt from * to end [32 sts]
Rnd 11: *K2, K2tog, yo; rpt from * to end [32 sts]
Rnd 12: Knit all sts
Rnd 13: *K4, M1; rpt from * to end [40sts]

Work plain stocking stitch for a further 2 inches/5cm.

Cast off all sts.

Drawstring:

Cast on 3 sts.
Work I-Cord for around 20" or as long as you fancy. Thread through eyelets and gather up.

Finishing:

Weave in all ends. Only a light blocking is needed, if at all.

Sloochie
